Dear Lowell:

We have reviewed the subject plan in the Five-Year Permit Renewal Package and consent to approval of this facility as a separate permit amendment.

In addition, we received a letter from Genwal Coal Company, dated May 26, 1988. A carbon copy of this letter was also sent to your office (copy enclosed). In this letter, Genwal Coal Company requested a 3 week extension on the approved period of operations for the temporary screening facility which expired on June 1st.

The approved period of operations for this temporary facility has been extended on several occasions in order to allow Genwal Coal Company to plan and permit the permanent loadout facility. We are reluctant to consent to another extension, however, since the permanent loadout facility is approved and arrangements for temporary screening are being made, we will consent to the deadline being extended to June 30, 1988. If any unjustified delays in pursuing other alternatives and in construction of the permanent facility occur, a Notice of Violation should be issued and the temporary facility must be removed. We intend to keep in close communication with the Division and Genwal Coal Company regarding this issue.
