





ISSUES

I. CRANDALL CANYON

Bill Wollen reviewed the portal site plan for Crandall Canyon. Tim Simmons noted the site was toured today by Don Almond, Tim Simmons, Scott Johansen and Bill Wollen. Progress on the road was reviewed. Site will limit production. Site will consist of generator, trailer, settling pond, 2 stock piles, underground water storage and a through road.

The mine will be a one section mine. Coal will be crushed underground. Stockpiles will be 2,500 tons. Mine is permitted for 150,000 tons per year. The old mine was called the "TIP-TOP". It was mined from 1938 to 1955. Production of this mine is now scheduled for March 1982. Bill Wollen estimated 60 days for Department of Oil, Gas and Mining's approval. Staffing levels for 1 shift will be 10-12 men. No bath house will be built at this time. Site plan will be in concept only. Coal will be loaded at Site #3, Hiawatha.

Dan Wells made a motion to recommend approval of the preliminary site plan to the County Commissioners. The motion was seconded by Ken Silliman and passed unanimously by the members.


