Summary

The Mohrland Screening and Crushing Facility plan, received May 18, 1988, has been reviewed for completeness and technical adequacy for engineering information. The information and plans proposed by the operator for this section are considered to be adequate.

Analysis

Genwal proposes to utilize an existing and previously disturbed loadout area at Mohrland, Utah. The requested permit term is for 6 months. Temporary equipment will be brought on the site for the screening and crushing of coal and the loading of this coal into railroad cars.

Equipment to be brought onto the site consists of a triple deck screen, a 36" roller crusher and associated conveyors for the facility. Power will be provided for the equipment from a portable 250 Hp diesel driven generator. Loading into the railcars will be accomplished by either the stacking conveyor or a 7 yard front end loader.

The operator has maintained that there will be no coal waste material generated on the site and that no waste material will be brought onto the site. No contouring and grading is proposed on the site in conjunction with the construction or the reclamation of the site. A four inch layer of road base is proposed to improve the existing roads for haulage trucks.
