The Division has finished its review of the above referenced Permit change received May 18, 1988. The Division hereby issues approval for the temporary facility contingent upon Genwal's acceptance and adherence to the following conditions.

Condition #1

Prior to any installation of equipment or other disturbance of the area Genwal must post a \$10,000 reclamation surety. This must be in the form of cash or other liquid assets.

Condition #2

The term of this approval will be for six months from the date of this letter. No extensions will be granted.

Condition #3

The operator must sample all waters discharged from the permit area for TSS, TDS, Total Iron, and Manganese. The samples must be collected and analyzed according to Standard Methods (or similar standard practices) and the results submitted to the Division within 45 days of the sample date. The applicant must also repair and remove all damage as a result of drainage structure failure due to precipitation events less than and including a 10 yr - 24 hr precipitation event.


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Condition #4

The operator must provide documentation from the existing landowner that the spillway structure will remain and meets the landowners requirements for a permanent structure or, the applicant must commit to removal of the spillway. The conditions of this stipulation must be met prior to cessation and abandonment of operations or December 31, 1988, whichever is sooner.

Once the Division has received the surety and written acceptance of these conditions, use of the temporary screening and crushing area may begin. Please feel free to contact me or Susan Linner should there be questions.
