Re: Mohrland Temporary Screening and Crushing Facility, Genwal Coal Company, ACT/015/032, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

This will serve as notification to Genwal Coal Company that the permit issued for the Mohrland Temporary Screening and Crushing Facility on June 28, 1988, will expire on December 28, 1988.

In accordance with the Conditional Approval and the reclamation plan for the Mohrland Facility, all screening and crushing must stop as of that date. Genwal will then have 30 days to remove the processing equipment (p. 3-2, Mohrland Facility Plan), and all signs and markers.

In accord with Condition #4 to the approval, Genwal must provide documentation from the Utah Railway that they wish the spillway structure to remain prior to December 28, 1988, or else the spillway structure must be removed on the same schedule as the other facilities.
