This letter responds to the above-referenced Ten-Day Notice (TDN), the certified copy of which was received at the Division's offices on March 9, 1989.

1. Number 1 of 1 reads: "All surface drainage from the disturbed, including disturbed areas that have been graded, seeded or planted, shall be passed through a sedimentation pond, a series of ponds, or a treatment facility before leaving the permit area -- Location: the drainage from the Forest Service parking lot / snow storage, the outslope of the road from the truck turnaround to the loading area (approximately 220 feet of outslope) and the three topsoil stockpiles located along USFS Haul Road."

Response - The omission of designation of these areas as Small Area Exemptions in the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) is a permit defect. Due to topography or location none of these areas can report to the sedimentation pond. All are currently being protected by alternative methods of sediment control. Through issuance of a Field Amendment during the oversight inspection (copy attached) the Division has already taken action to have these areas incorporated into the MRP as Small Area


