RE: Status of Amendments ACT/015/032-89A, C, D; Stipulations 771.23-1 - SCL and USFS-1, Genwal Coal Company, Crandall Canyon Mine, ACT/015/032, Carbon County, Utah

The purpose of this review was to ensure that the approved text, calculations and revised plates relative to the above items were included in the resubmitted MRP received by the Division on February 26, 1990. The final approval letter and transmittal of these amendments was delayed to allow the operator time to reformat and resubmit the MRP in it's entirety.

All of the referenced amendments and stipulation responses have been included in the new MRP. The inclusions are all complete as per the original amendment submittals. A final approval letter should be drafted for these items with the condition that 14 copies of the complete MRP (3 volumes) be submitted for transmittal to other agencies.

In addition, it was noted in this review that the following concerns should be addressed in the resubmitted volumes:

1. Several pages in the volumes are poor, illegible copies. The applicant should ensure that all copies are legible prior to resubmittal.
2. All designs (calculations and plates) need to be certified (signed) and dated. For example, the lead page(s) to the design appendices in volume 7 need a signature and date.

It was also noted in this review that final approval letters for Stipulation 817.48-1-2 - JSL and amendment ACT/015/032-89B may not have been sent. The files should be checked to ensure final approval was issued.

My records indicate that Stipulations 817.121-126 - DWD and 784.13-1 - JRH still need review and approval.
