Mine, Genwal Coal Company, ACT/015/032-90E, Folder #2,  
Emery County, Utah

On August 31, 1990, the Division received a request to expand the Crandall Canyon Mine haulage road just north of the sediment pond. Inasmuch as this request was in the form of a letter rather than amendment form and no certified designs were included, the proposal can not be approved at this time.

The Division hereby denies the above-referenced amendment. The Division has no problem with the concept of expanding the haul road and you may want to resubmit the proposal at some future date; however, proper amendment format should be followed and enough copies submitted for all interested agencies to review. An amendment should be in a format that, upon approval, can be inserted directly into the mine plan and become a part of that plan.

RE: Amendment to Surface Facilities

Dear Mr. Braxton:


We are requesting at this time an amendment to our surface facility. We request your consideration on the following area. We would like to expand the width of the mine haulage road located just north of the sediment pond and southeast of the truck loadout. We propose to fill this area with large rocks, constructing a solid foundation as a base and then backfill and compact with a roadbase material up to the existing road level. The result of these efforts will widen the road at this location. The sediment pond will not be affected by this construction. The drainage ditch leading to the sediment pond will be rip-rapped with rock to prevent erosion. The present ditch size will not be compromised by this process. Once the road expansion is in place, we would like to place a solid concrete barrier at the edge of the road to act as a safety barricade as per advise of the Mine Safety and Health Administration. Also it will aid in the control of drainage and erosion of this area. Please refer to the attached map for exact location and area involved.
