Public notice pursuant to UMC 786.11(a) R614-300-121.100 is hereby given regarding the proposed underground mining activities of Genwal Coal Company.

Genwal Coal Company, P.O. Box 1201, Huntington, Utah has submitted to the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining a complete mining permit application for Utah State lease ML-21568 (T16S-R6E-Sec2) and ML-21569 (T15S-R6E-Sec36) of Emery County. Leases ML-21568 (998 acres) and ML-21569 (640 acres) lie in Crandall and Blind Canyons, respectively. These areas are contained in the U.S.G.S. Rilda Canyon 7.5 minute map.
