Re: Correction of the Legal Description of Lease SL-062648 in Previous Division Communications and Division Order to Update Federal Lease SL-062648, Genwal Coal Company, Crandall Canyon Mine, ACT 015/032, Folder #3, Emery County, Utah

Recently, it has been brought to my attention that in three (3) previous Division communications, coal leases SL-062648 and U-54762 and the Underground Access Right of Way were described as being located in the Township 15 South, Range 17 East, SLBM. This was an error. Both leases and Right of Way are in Township 15 South, Range 7 East, SLBM.


The letters in question were dated August 23, 1990, Re: Notification of Permit Approval Underground Access Right of Way; August 8, 1990, Re: Revised State Permit and Decision Package; and August 23, 1990, Re: Notice of Permit Approval for the Underground Access Right of Way to the Newspaper Agency Corporation.

The Division is aware of these clerical errors and this communication serves as documentation of this awareness. The Division will republish the Notice of Permit Approval for the Underground Access Right of Way after the Emery County Recorder receives all the updated information required by the enclosed Division Order of January 14, 1991.

**DIVISION ORDER AND FINDINGS
of
PERMIT DEFICIENCY**

PURSUANT to **R614-303-212**, the DIVISION hereby ORDERS the PERMITTEE, Genwal Coal Company, to make the permit changes enumerated in the FINDINGS OF PERMIT DEFICIENCY in order to be in compliance with the State Coal Program. These FINDINGS OF PERMIT DEFICIENCY are to be remedied in accordance with **R614-303-220**.

FINDINGS OF PERMIT DEFICIENCY

- 1) **R614-300-121.200** requires that the applicant file any changes to the application with the public office at the same time the change is submitted to the Division. In the case of Crandall Canyon Mine, the Emery County Recorder's office must receive the original copies of Plat Maps, and certified copies of all documents affecting lease agreements.

To achieve compliance with this rule, the operator must obtain a copy of the "Serial Register Page," for lease SL-062648 from the Public Room of the Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) Salt Lake City office and file this information in the Emery County Recorder's office. 
- 2) **R614-301-111.100** requires that all relevant information on the ownership and control of the property to be affected by the operation is provided in the Permit Application to the Division.

To achieve compliance with this rule, the operator must update the Mining and Reclamation Plan to include items (e), (f), & (g) as listed above in Finding 1. The Mining and Reclamation Plan must also be updated to include an accurate Permit and Lease Area map.

ORDER

Genwal Coal Company is ORDERED to address the FINDINGS OF PERMIT DEFICIENCY in accordance with **R614-300-121.200** and **R614-301-111.100**, within 60 days of receipt of this order.
