Re: Conditional Approval, Incidental Boundary Change, Genwal Coal Company, Inc., Crandall Canyon Mine, ACT/015/032-92C, Folders #2 and #3, Emery County, Utah

The Division hereby grants a conditional approval for an incidental boundary change proposed in revision ACT/015/032-92C, effective April 29, 1992. This change in the permit boundary accounts for an addition to the permit area of approximately 50 acres and is as shown on plate 3-3A, Underground Mine Projections and Mining Boundaries.

Conditions to this approval are as follows:

1. The terms and conditions of the Special Use Permit issued by the USFS and the noted concerns in the letter dated April 24, 1992 must be addressed by Genwal and submitted to the division on or before May 18, 1992 in conjunction with information required under Division Order ACT/015/032#92A. These outstanding concerns by the Forest Service are primarily in regard to Chapter 14 revisions to the mining and reclamation plan. (Copies Attached)
2. All pertinent changes to the text of the Mining and Reclamation Plan, maps and drawings must be completed by Genwal and submitted to the Division on or before May 18, 1992. These changes are to be submitted in conjunction with the information required under Division Order ACT/015/032#92-A.

Failure to submit complete and accurate information in regard to the above conditions for the Incidental Boundary Change and the Division Order may result in enforcement action


Please note that the permit buffer zone has been removed.

Genwal Coal Company has been working with the Division, State Lands, and USFS since November of 1991 to modify our approved permit to allow for second mining. Genwal went to the extent of moving its underground mining operations three miles, in addition to changing the entire mine layout, to allow for more time for the permitting process. Pillar retreat mining is scheduled to begin Monday the 20th of April.
