This letter is in regard to a mitigation project proposed in correspondence from our office dated April 28, 1993. As part of the Completeness Review of Genwal's MRP, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining required some type of mitigation to replace wildlife values lost as a result of the approximately five acres occupied by surface facilities in Crandall Canyon. In the above correspondence, the Division of Wildlife Resources outlined a proposal for the construction of a fish barrier on the Left Fork of Huntington Creek. It is our understanding that this project was approved by Genwal and included in the MRP.

The suggested starting date for this project was between August and October of this year. Due to the time required to obtain the necessary permits and develop the appropriate design, we would like to begin the process so that there is adequate time to complete the project. We would appreciate any information you could provide regarding the status of this mitigation project.
