- 4d. Sampling of ground and surface water has been done but results are not back from the laboratory yet. Springs 30 and 36 were not accessible due to high stream flow. Water from within the mine has not been sampled yet this quarter.
- 4e. NPDES reports have not been prepared for this quarter yet, but there has been no discharge according to Genwal personnel.
- 9. Beaver have enlarged the ponds in Crandall Creek. Water in the stream is clear but fish have not yet been seen in the ponds.
- 13. The vegetation reference area was located by Larry Johnson, and George Cook of the SCS checked it on Wednesday, June 9. Thistle and halogeton were found alongside the road within the disturbed area. Genwal intends to control all thistle, irrespective of species, within the disturbed area.
- 21. The surety bond was renewed on May 10, 1993.
