## SUMMARY AND ANALYSIS

On December 9, 1993, the Division received a response to the deficiencies noted in the November 8, 1993, submittal of a permit transfer application. All of the deficiencies noted in my previous memorandum have been adequately addressed. However, the submittal was not accompanied by the notarized signature of a responsible official of the applicant that the information in the application is true and correct to the best of the official's information and belief.

There are a few minor errors in the transfer application that do not necessarily need to be corrected. On page nine, the permit number is listed as ACT/015/035. It should be ACT/015/032 instead. Also on page nine, there is no complete description of the Beaver Creek or Mountain Coal Co. lease area; however, this area is fully described elsewhere. The text of the application does not show the owners of contiguous areas, but Plate 1-1, included in the application, shows these owners.

## RECOMMENDATION

The Division needs to receive a copy of the notarized signature of a responsible official of the applicant that the information in the application is true and correct to the best of the official's information and belief. The information in this transfer application appears to be correct and complete with the minor exceptions noted above.
