This letter is written to verify the agreements reached in our meeting of August 3, 1993 regarding your truck scale project.

Lengthening the truck scale was agreed to with the provision that the forest road width not be reduced to less than 14 feet. It is our understanding that the Forest Service has already been contacted regarding this change. A culvert installation and wall extension also are appropriate as long as the culvert is at least 24" in diameter.

These changes are considered minor construction alterations which do not increase disturbed area or effect drainage and will not effect the ability of the site to meet performance standards. Therefore these modifications are approved as part of your project with the condition that they be included in as-built drawings. Appropriate numbers of text and map changes must be submitted to the Division within 30 days of project completion.
