The material submitted for the IBC has been reviewed for technical completeness. A few minor deficiencies have been found and are discussed below. The CHIA done by Dave Darby in 1991 covered this IBC area, and the entire LBA submittal area. There is no need to update the CHIA.

1.14 Right of Entry and Operation

Proposal:

Federal Coal Lease U-68082 to be assigned to the Joint Owners in March, 1994. The IBC is within this lease and is the only part approved to mine until the LBA #9 submittal to DOGM is approved (p. 1-12).

Analysis:

Federal Coal Lease U-68082 is not shown on Plate 1-1a. On Plate 1-1A, the IBC area can mistakenly be assumed to be part of the adjacent state lease ML-25169. Plate 1-1 in the currently approved MRP shows the outline of the LBA area but does not identify the federal lease. The federal lease is identified on Plate 1-1 in the LBA submittal, but that submittal is not a part of the approved MRP.

Deficiency:

Plate 1-1A does not show Federal Coal Lease U-068082 and its relation to the IBC.



Proposal:

Total acreage contained within the IBC is 152.18 acres, more or less (Description of IBC in Appendix 1-1). New Incidental Boundary Change - 143.91 acres (p. 4 of the Introduction).

Analysis/Deficiency:

Two different sizes for the IBC are given in the submitted material.

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
