My initial review of the IBC permit change submittal identified two deficiencies. Genwal has provided additional information that satisfies those deficiencies.

Plate 1-1 has been updated to show federal lease UTU-68082, which has been issued to Genwal, and location of the IBC in relation to the coal leases. This change to Plate 1-1, instead of to Plate 1-1A, provides the needed clarification of the relationship between the IBC and the new lease.

The Addendum to Appendix 1-1 and Page 4 of the Introduction now both show 152.18 acres within the IBC.

The CHIA prepared by Dave Darby for the Genwal permit was mentioned in the TCR memo dated February 22, 1994. Ken Wyatt is preparing a CHIA that covers lower Huntington Canyon, basically downstream from Nuck Woodward Canyon, and that includes the Genwal Crandall Canyon mine.

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
