ORDER & FINDINGS
of
PERMIT DEFICIENCY

PERMIT NUMBER ACT/015/032
DIVISION ORDER # 94A

PURSUANT to R645-303-212, the DIVISION ORDERS the PERMITTEE, Genwal Coal Company (permittee), to make the permit changes enumerated in the findings of permit deficiency in order to be in compliance with the State Coal Program. These findings of permit deficiency are to be remedied in accordance with R645-303-220.

FINDINGS OF PERMIT DEFICIENCY

The Division finds the permit deficient in that the Surety Rider dated May 10, 1990 does not adequately describe the Obligee.

30 CFR 944.30 Article IX


Requirements

In order to comply with these regulations, the permittee must correct the surety rider to describe the obligee as State of Utah, Division of Oil, Gas and Mining and U. S. Department of Interior, Office of Surface Mining.

ORDER

Genwal Coal Company (Permittee) is ordered to make the requisite permit changes in accordance with R645-303-220 and to submit a corrected Surety Rider within 30 days of date of the Order.
