



Dear Mr. Haddock:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has reviewed the subject mine plan amendment with regards to the R2P2 portion of the plan. Genwal was notified in a letter dated April 12, 1995, of deficiencies in the R2P2. Genwal responded on May 11, 1995, addressing all deficiencies. We find that the R2P2 amendment to change to longwall mining methods complies with the Mineral Leasing Act of 1920, as amended, the regulations at 43 CFR 3480, the lease terms and conditions, and will achieve maximum economic recovery of the Federal coal. We recommend approval of the amendment.
