





Genwal Resources, Inc. respectfully requests that the Divisions request for resubmittal of all ASCA/SAE at the Crandall Canyon Mine by July 25, 1995 be extended for a period of 45 days. This request is made because text and plate changes will be the only changes required (all field stabilization and revegetation has been in place for several years). Also, as you are aware, by mid- to late-August Genwal will be submitting a major amendment which alters our surface facilities to allow for culverting Crandall Creek. Thus, all plates and text associated with our MRP and the surface facilities are being redone to reflect the proposed changes.

Genwal will also submit, as a part of the major amendment, the minimum stream flows to be left in Crandall Canyon during periods of low flow. As a part of the major amendment we are altering portions of Chapters 2,3,4,5,6, and 7.
