RE: Chronology of Designation of Operator Information, Genwal Coal Company, Crandall Canyon Mine, ACT/015/032-94G, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

On December 12, 1994, representatives for Genwal Coal Company, John Kirkham and Denise Dragoo met with James Carter, Lowell Braxton, and myself at the Division to discuss the changes forthcoming for Genwal Coal Company. At the meeting it was discussed that NEICO will be selling their interest in Genwal Coal Company to Andalex Resources, Inc. It was discussed what would be done. It was decided that a new operator would be designated, Genwal Resources, Inc. and then a permit transfer would be sought. At that meeting, the representatives were advised that a permit change should be submitted as soon as possible for the designation of operator and the updated operator information would be input for an AVS check. It was noted that this permit change should be submitted as soon as possible, because on December 21, 1994 I would be on annual for the Christmas holiday until January.

On December 20, 1994, I received the permit change designation of operator information. On December 21, 1994, the Division tried to update the AVS system. However, on that date the AVS system was down the entire day.

On January 3, 1995, I received a letter from Denise Dragoo that replaced a faxed signature page with an original signature page. On that date and for the next several days, updated operator information with the updated OFT and updated permit information was input into the AVS system and an OSM recommendation was requested. On January 6, 1995 an "issue" recommendation was posted.

The bond for the Crandall Canyon Mine is posted by Genwal Coal Company, the permittee is Genwal Coal Company.
