Re: Stipulations and Conditions to Warehouse Expansion, Genwal Coal Company, Crandall Canyon Mine, ACT/015/032-95E, Folder #3, Emery County, Utah

On April 24, 1995 the Division received an application from Genwal Coal Company to expand their existing warehouse by approximately 20 X 40 feet. The expansion takes place on previously permitted/disturbed area. No concerns were identified through the Division's review. The U. S. Forest Service was contacted regarding this expansion and has consented to the expansion with the following stipulations. (Phone conversation with Jeff Defreest 6/20/95)

1. The building expansion must be painted compatibly with the surrounding buildings and in accordance with Forest color schemes.
2. The construction of the additional warehouse space will not be construed as expanding to allow other areas for outside storage. (i. e. materials previously stored outside for which the expansion is built, should be stored inside.)
3. Genwal must keep the Forest road and public access through the mine site clear and free from obstruction.

One condition should be attached to the approval. That appropriate numbers of copies of the plans and as-builts be submitted.
