Dear Mr. Gainer:

The permit change to extend the existing warehouse is approved, effective June 20, 1995, with three stipulations and one condition:

Stipulation #1 - The building expansion must be painted compatibly with the surrounding buildings and in accordance with Forest Service color schemes,

Stipulation #2 - The construction of the additional warehouse space will not be construed as expanding to allow other areas for outside storage, i.e., material previously stored outside for which the expansion is built, must be stored inside, and

Stipulation #3 - Genwal Resources, Inc. must keep the Forest Service road and public access through the mine site clear and free from obstruction.
