Dear Mr. Gray:

This letter is to notify Genwal Resources, Inc. ("Genwal") of the decision of the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining to approve the application for culverting 1400 feet of Crandall Creek and expanding the surface facilities area at the Crandall Canyon Mine. The Division has conducted a thorough review of the application, including comments and objections received by the Division from state and federal agencies, and the public and has prepared a Technical Analysis ("TA") of all the materials and comments submitted in regard to the application. Based upon the entire record, the Division finds the application to be in compliance with the Utah Coal Regulatory Program, state law and the regulations governing coal mining in the State of Utah. A copy of the TA is enclosed for your information and records.

Before Genwal may conduct development or mining operations in the expanded permit area, a reclamation bond in the amount of at least \$1,654,000 must be posted with the Division. Once the required bond is posted, a revised permit will be issued which will authorize mining in the expanded area as proposed.
