Dear Mr. Gray:


Division staff have been inputting hydrologic data into the Division hydrologic database for all of the coal mines. It has come to my attention that there are discrepancies in the data for the Crandall Canyon Mine.

Last Tuesday, July 15, 1997, I spoke with you on the telephone about spring data that has been identified incorrectly. You stated that you would, in the future, verify that all of the monitoring points would be identified in the field and reported correctly.

Now, I am enclosing data where there are discrepancies that are included in Appendix 7-23 versus monthly stream flow data that was submitted to the Division. For purposes of illustration, some of the discrepancies have been highlighted. Please notify me by July 31, 1997 and let me know which flows are correct for the Upper Flume of Crandall Creek.
