REQUEST FOR COMMENTS Manti LaSal National Forest Ferron/Price Ranger District Emery County, Utah

The Forest Service and Bureau of Land Management (BLM) are evaluating an Underground Right-of-Way (ROW) application submitted to the BLM by Genwal Coal Company. The proposed ROW would allow Genwal to extend underground development workings from State lands into their Crandall Canyon Mine permit area westward into adjacent unleased Federal coal reserves on National Forest System (NFS) lands. The purpose is to maximize coal production. Increased production is estimated at approximately 260,000 tons. Full-support development workings on NFS lands would not cause subsidence, however subsidence from full-extraction longwall panels on State lands could extend westward onto the adjacent NFS lands (0 to 480 ft. over a north-south distance of approx. 1 mile). A Forest Service Special-Use permit could be required to authorize subsidence of NFS lands. Other than subsidence, effects to NFS resources are anticipated to be negligible and no extraordinary circumstances are anticipated. Monitoring of the effects of subsidence has shown negligible effects to NFS resources from similar actions. If no extraordinary circumstances or significant effects are identified through scoping/analysis, the agencies anticipate documenting the environmental analysis in a Decision Memo because it would qualify for categorical exclusion from documentation in an Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement (FSH 1909.15, Section 31.1b, Item 7).

The longwall panels and State lands are located in Section 2, T. 16 S., R. 6 E., SLM, Emery County, Utah. The ROW would encompass portions Sections 3 and 10 along their boundary with Section 2 in this township. The affected area and associated permits could encompass approximately 50 acres of NFS lands.
