Gentlefolk:

I only recently received a copy of your June 1, 1999, notification that Genwal Coal Company has applied for a Right Of Way across U.S.F.S. lands in Sections 3 & 10, T17S, R6E, SLB&M, Emery County, Utah.

I understand that the granting of said R.O.W. will enable Genwal Coal Company to extend the planned longwall coal mining panels within Section 2 further to the West and thus recover additional coal reserves from Section 2 and from the adjacent federal lands.

The School and Institutional Trust Lands Administration supports this action and urges the U.S.F.S. to approve the R.O.W. application. The Trust Lands Administration concurs with such modification of the mine plan as may be necessary to incorporate the proposed R.O.W. and allow additional recovery of coal from Section 2.
