Dear Mr. Anderson:

This letter is in response to your telephone call to the Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining, Price Field Office on April 29, 2003 about coal mine waste being dumped on some private surface between Cleveland and Elmo, Utah. Pete Hess took the call and responded by personally interviewing you about the situation on April 30, 2003. He said that four to five yards of material have been dumped on lands owned by Mrs. Smiles Oveson.

He also mentioned that you believed that this material probably came from Genwal Resources, Inc., but was not sure. Mr. Hess discussed this situation with Mr. Gary Gray, an engineer at Genwal Resource's Crandall Canyon Mine. Mr. Gray indicated that he had no knowledge of coal mine waste leaving the Crandall Canyon Mine property.
