2. Signs and Markers

Inspected the mine ID sign. The sign contains outdated information. This item has been identified in previous inspections. The operator was reminded that the sign needs to be updated to comply with R645-301-521.240. Compliance with R645-301-521.240 will avoid future enforcement action. The operator committed to having this problem corrected prior to the next inspection.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

The mine site diversions are mostly snow covered. Several diversions have had snow removed from them by the operator. The diversions observed during the inspection were functional. The operator will continue to monitor and maintain them.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The sediment pond is iced over. When the pond thaws the operator needs to survey the pond and re-install the sediment level marker.

4.d Hydrologic Balance: Water Monitoring

Third quarter 2003 water monitoring information is in the EDI website and has been uploaded. Fourth quarter 2003 water monitoring has been done. This information will need to be submitted and uploaded when the information is available. Water monitoring is current.
