SCAMP Excavation has done a very nice job of reclamation on the east portion of the SITLA access road and the shothole road (photos attached). The seeding has not been done yet. Construction on the new alignment is complete and is featured in the photos as well.

 Here is the current plugging status for the Crandall Canyon Mine drill holes. fyi.

Pam...The drilling company has mobilized all equipment and materials to the Flat Canyon staging area. Due the pending storm, SITLA has determined to postpone all activities until Monday. According to the drillers, and weather permitting, they will move everything up to the drillhole sites on Monday, and set up on drillpad #5, which is the upper pad, to start plugging. This is a SITLA hole. They hope to get the trim-pipe down Monday evening and begin putting concrete in the hole on Tuesday morning. After pugging hole #5 the plan to move to the lowermost hole #3 (which is a BLM hole) and anticipated pouring concrete on Wednesday morning. All parties involved (BLM, DOGM, Sitla) on the local level have been kept informed of the projected schedule as it evolves. Please let me know if there is anything else you need.
