Subject: Directions for bond proposal and pmlu change

Hello Dave,

I have some information to relay to you regarding the Crandall Canyon bond release proposal that the Division is expecting on December 13, 2007. The following three items should be included in the proposal:

1. Revise the Crandall Cyn permit area to include a "cherry stem" into T 16 S, R 6 E, Sec 11 to illustrate the location of the road that was bladed outside of the existing permit area, on USFS managed land.
2. Provide a new permit area map and disturbed area map with the application. Describe disturbed and permit acreage in terms of federal, state, and fee surface and subsurface ownership.
3. The bond should describe the worst case scenario of full reclamation of all disturbance associated with the emergency action (including roads).

Under a separate application, you should apply for a post mining land use change to retain the road across East Mountain to support a commercial/industrial post mining land use on SITLA managed land. This will require a revision of Chapter 4 of the MRP, since the current land use and post mining land use for the permit area is described as rangeland and wildlife/grazing, respectively. Chapter 4 should be updated to include SITLA as a landowner, since it currently states that the post mining land use is at the "sole discretion" of the USFS. The requirements for a post mining land use change are listed under R645-301-413.300 through 414.300. An application for an alternative post mining land use will require public notification as described in R645-300-120 and may involve a public hearing, as described in R645-300-200.
