Dave,

I am newly assigned as they Hydrologist for Crandall Canyon. I am trying to catch up on some neglected water monitoring reports, and familiarize myself with the MRP requirements.

On page 7-42 of the MRP, incorporated in 2005, it says:

"Baseline water quality samples will be collected quarterly from the stream monitoring station below the forks in Horse Canyon at location H-I (Plate 7-16) and analyzed according to the list contained in Table 7-8. Instantaneous flow estimates will be made for stations H-I, HS-5, and HN-I during the spring and summer water quality sampling event. This monitoring will continue for a period of three years at which time the need for continued monitoring of Horse canyon will be evaluated."

I don't see any of these sites even in the database. Has this sampling been taking place? I will add the sites to the database, and hope you have the information as required. If not, I guess Pam will have to decide what to do, in addition to starting to do such sampling from here forward.
