Subject Crandall Wall Progress

Gentlemen,

This email is being sent to update you concerning the block walls for the Crandall Mine. The block wall have holes in each wall to dewater any impounded water, this water is being drained to a central location and pumped to the discharge line going over the hill side to the creek. We are finalizing the details for the dewatering system to handle the water for the time the mine is idle. Pipes will be installed in each wall and routed to a central location for gravity discharge to the pipe that leads to the creek. Weather conditions have made it extremely difficult to install the pipes in the walls. It is requested that additional time be granted to complete the wall work due to the cold weather conditions. UEI will be forwarding plans for the dewatering system early next week.
