Dave,

One last thing before I disappear into the California sun, I wanted to give you a heads up on something that came up in discussion after yesterdays site visit.

Last year was last year. You guys were going great guns to get as much done as you could, as fast as you could, as best you could, without a plan and it turned out great. However, now there's a plan to follow. As such, it's of utmost importance that the Scamp folks on the ground are aware of what's in it, what's expected and who to take direction from at the site.

It's my understanding that last year there was some confusion as to who was to do what, when etc. For example, in talking with Scamp representatives yesterday, they indicated that they were extremely upset when the initial SITLA road alignment was not poked following it's reclamation. It's my understanding from that conversation that Adam Robison from SITLA made the call to leave that reclaimed surface smooth (which was not what was discussed and agreed upon). This type of thing can't happen going forward.

The Forest has made it clear (and the Division concurs) that the work will be done by your contractor's only and that they should be taking their marching orders only from you, not SITLA.

I'm writing this in an effort to avoid any misunderstandings or problems as work begins and continues through the remainder of the construction season.
