Dear Mr. Shaver:

On September 24th, 2008, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (the Division) received your request via e-mail to extend the time frame for responding to Division Order DO08A-2957. Based on your June 18th, 2008 letter to the Division (See attached) and our subsequent conversations thereafter, it's my understanding that your intention is to submit an amendment to the Crandall Canyon MRP that addresses both the mine water discharge issue (as outlined in Division Order DO08A-2957) as well as the reclamation modifications necessitated by the construction of the Crandall Canyon Memorial.

As you are aware, this is your second request for more time to submit the aforementioned MRP modifications. The Division granted a time extension on July 2nd, 2008 (See attached) to facilitate the preparation and submission of this information. Please keep in mind that the MRP modifications outlined above are necessary and overdo.

However, due to the pressing and immediate concerns associated with methane degasification at the West Ridge Mine, you are hereby granted an extension to December 1st, 2008 to submit the aforementioned revisions to the Crandall Canyon MRP.

Dear Mr. Haddock:

On April 22, 2008 we received Division Order DO08A, Task 2957 to amend the Mining & Reclamation Plan to address the mine water discharge coming from the Crandall Canyon Mine portals. Since this mine has been closed, all work on containing this discharge at the portals has involved subsequent approvals from MSHA and BLM, which we have been working to obtain. Also, any final reclamation plan will require concurrence from the Forest Service, since the portals are on their land. We have had on-site meetings with them recently to get their initial input, which we will propose in the plan amendment to the Division.

In a related development, we have recently deeded part of the upper mineyard over to Emery County as part of the memorial to the miners who were killed on August 6, 2007. Since this memorial will remain as a permanent structure we will have to amend the reclamation plan for this situation as well. Since we now have two components of change to the reclamation plan (water discharge and memorial) we propose to address both in a single submittal. Because some of the necessary elements of these plans have only recently come together (BLM/MSHA portal plan approval, FS input to plan, and deeding of memorial land to Emery County), we hereby request a three month extension to submit the amended reclamation plan. This time is needed to get the necessary engineering together, and to allow sufficient time for the more pressing requirements of completing the memorial by August 6, 2008, and completing the reclamation plan for the East Mountain drillpads/roads in order to start the work this summer
