Dear Mr. Faddies:

Attached is a letter from the Manti-La Sal National Forest requesting that Genwal Resources, Inc. reclaim the East Mountain Emergency Access Road, as required under the terms of the Special Use Permit granted for its utilization. This letter will serve as Genwal's notification to SITLA that we intend to comply with this request by reclaiming the Forest Service segment of road later in this summer, 2010. Because this emergency road also continues onto SITLA land, we hereby request written permission from your office to reclaim the SITLA segment at the same time. As you are aware, we acknowledge the responsibility to reclaim the full length of emergency road, and have posted reclamation bonds with the Forest Service for their segment and with DOGM for the SITLA segment. If SITLA agrees to allow reclamation of your segment at this time, we will begin making the necessary arrangements with the contractor to ensure that this work can be completed later this summer.

I respectfully request that you proceed with reclamation of the East Mountain, Forest Service portion of the temporary emergency access road as outlined in the SUP (Special Use Permit) issued on April 16th, 2008. The road was constructed for emergency access on August 7, 2007 due to the Crandall Canyon Mine accident. The lands covered by the permit are located in the county of Emery, State of Utah and are described as follows: Sec. 11, T.16 S., R.6 E., Salt Lake Principle Meridian.
