Good morning,

As part of the permitting process of the iron treatment system at the Crandall Canyon Mine, a commitment was established to conduct a field visit once the snow had melted and a visual inspection of the stream channel could be performed. The purpose of the inspection would be to discuss (with all the respective regulatory agencies and company representatives) what could be done to remove/minimize the iron staining from the channel.
