Dear Mr. Shaver:

On July 15, 2010 the Division approved an amendment which allowed the temporary use of the Crandall Canyon sediment pond for short-term storage of iron sludge material during testing of new methods of sludge dewatering. The approved amendment identified the testing period to be temporary, ending October 30, 2010. The Division understands that unusually warm weather has made it possible to continue testing, that you have materials available on-site for additional testing of geofabric filtration devices and that you desire to perform additional testing and pond cleanout activities prior to the onset of winter conditions at the site.

By this letter the Division authorizes an extension of the temporary use of the Crandall Canyon sediment pond for short-term storage of iron sludge material until November 14, 2010. This extension does not affect the deadline for complying with commitments for revising Appendix 7-65 of the MRP by November 30, 2010 as described in our letter dated July 15, 2010.
