On behalf of Genwal Resources, Inc. ("Genwal"), we respectfully request an extension of time in which to abate Notice of Violation N-10073 ("NOV") to accommodate the Board's Order that the parties undertake settlement discussions in Docket No. 2010-026, Cause No. C/015/0032F, In the Matter of Genwal's Request for Board Review of Division Order No. 10-A. The extension will allow Genwal until June 15, 2011 to submit a summary of equipment costs and projected annual operations / maintenance cost for the current mine water treatment system at the Crandall Canyon Mine.
