Dear Mr. Shaver:

The above-referenced amendment was submitted in response to Notice of Violation #10073 (NOV #10073). The amendment is conditionally approved with the following stipulations:

- 1) Provide 8 clean copies (2 copies may be in an electronic format) and;
- 2) Revise the language contained in the 2<sup>nd</sup> full paragraph on page 15 of Appendix 7-65. The Permittee must provide a commitment that within 60 days of final approval of the Burma Evaporation Basin (Task ID #3997); the site will be constructed and operational. A sentence must also be added acknowledging that within 60 days of the final approval of the Burma Evaporation Basin, that continued utilization of the Crandall Canyon sediment pond for iron sludge disposal will no longer be authorized by the Division. Additionally, the last sentence of the 2<sup>nd</sup> full paragraph of page 15 of Appendix 7-65 should be deleted as final approval for the special use permit has been granted by SITLA for the Burma Evaporation Basin site.

Please submit the clean copies and aforementioned text revisions by February 7, 2012. Once we receive the clean copies and revisions, final approval will be granted and NOV #10073 will be terminated.

A stamped incorporated copy of the approved plans will also be returned to you at that time, for insertion into your copy of the Mining and Reclamation Plan.
