Dear Mr. Shaver:

The above-referenced amendment was submitted in response to NOV #10073. On January 24<sup>th</sup>, the amendment was conditionally approved with the following stipulations:

- 1) Provide 8 clean copies (2 copies may be in an electronic format) and;
- 2) Revise the language contained in the 2<sup>nd</sup> full paragraph on page 15 of Appendix 7-65. The Permittee must provide a commitment that within 60 days of final approval of the Burma Evaporation Basin (Task ID #3997); the site will be constructed and operational. A sentence must also be added acknowledging that within 60 days of the final approval of the Burma Evaporation Basin, that continued utilization of the Crandall Canyon sediment pond for iron sludge disposal will no longer be authorized by the Division. Additionally, the last sentence of the 2<sup>nd</sup> full paragraph of page 15 of Appendix 7-65 should be deleted as final approval for the special use permit has been granted by SITLA for the Burma Evaporation Basin site.

The conditions have been met and final approval granted for the amendment. Additionally, the abatement requirements for NOV #10073 have been satisfied and the violation is hereby terminated (See Attached).

A stamped incorporated copy of the approved plans are being returned to you at this time for insertion into your copy of the Mining and Reclamation Plan.
