Hello Scott,

The slide area was treated with 32 excelsior logs, placed in 9 rows on the contour. A row of pine trees was transplanted below the head cut of the slide as well. The slide area was re-seeded. The East Mountain Trail was re-routed around the west side of the saddle. The subsidence fractures were filled in and the trail has been reclaimed back to the red gate. The red gate will be removed and replaced by large boulders by the end of this week.
