Dear Mr. Faddies:

The Division has scheduled a Phase I bond release inspection of the reclaimed East Mountain emergency drill sites and access roads associated with the Crandall Canyon Mine for Wednesday October 10, 2012. In accordance with Utah Coal Mining Rule 645-301-880.210, you are invited to participate in this inspection. The area of Phase I release is as follows and is also shown on the attached map.

East Mountain Project: Township 15 South, Range 6 East, Parts of Section 35
Township 16 South, Range 6 East, Parts of Section 2

The inspection will commence on Wednesday, October 10, 2012 and we will meet at 9:00 a.m. at the Flat Canyon intersection of the Cottonwood Creek Rd (Forest Road 040) with the Indian Creek Rd (Forest Rd 017), approximately 9 miles north of Hwy 29. (We will take a couple vehicles down to Indian Creek to use as a return shuttle.)

The Division received an application for Phase I Bond Release for approximately 9.5 acres. The reclamation work began in the fall of 2007. Reclamation included backfilling and grading to AOC, and drainage control and was completed in September of 2011.

Please be prepared for a steep (downhill) hike over rough terrain. We will cover about four miles in walking the reclaimed USFS trail 085 and the reclaimed SITLA road and then down to each pad area. We will leave the site by way of Indian Creek and shuttle drivers back up to vehicles that were left at the East Mountain trail head. Please bring water, snacks, hat, sunscreen, rain gear, jacket and hiking boots. If you have any questions, please feel free to call me at (801) 538-5325.


