**R645-301-120, -121.200:** The Permittee must address the discrepancies found on the cover page of Appendix 7-4, *Crandall Canyon Mine Sedimentation and Drainage Control Plan*. At the bottom of that page, the Permittee has changed the revised date from November 2009 to June of 2005. The cover page for Appendix 7-4 in the approved MRP on file with the Division shows a revised date of September 2010 with Dan Guy's professional engineer certification stamp dated September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2010. It's unclear why the revised date for Appendix 7-4 was changed and why that date does not match the approved MRP. The revised date should reflect the current amendment being reviewed (i.e. July 2013). (SC)

**R645-301-120, -121.200:** The Permittee must reconcile the pagination of the proposed revisions to Appendix 7-4 with the approved MRP. Based upon a review of the approved MRP, there are pagination discrepancies with the revisions to Appendix 7-4. The submitted page 37 is page 36 in the approved MRP. In addition, two different versions of page 38 were submitted with the amendment. As a result, it's not possible to determine if the submitted revisions are reconcilable with the pagination of the approved MRP. (SC)
