Right of Entry

Analysis:

The amendment meets the State of Utah R645-301-114 requirements for Right of Entry Information.

Right of entry information is presented in Section 114. As indicated on page 1-8, the emergency nature of the disturbance on East Mountain required verbal approval by landowners in the rescue attempts. Right of Way was granted for reclamation efforts and that has since expired. However, pursuant to 43 CFR 3480.0-6(d)(8) and R645-303-232.500, there is no need to have a lease or other right of entry, because disturbed areas have been reclaimed or are in the process of being reclaimed.

The US Forest Service issued Special Use Permit #PRI-1608 for the Surface Facilities located on relinquished federal coal lease UTSL-062648 for 7.53 acres located in lots 6 & 9 (SW4NW4) Section 5, T.16S., R.7E.
