The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (the Division) is writing to formally withdraw Division Order DO-16A (DO-16A). As you recall, DO-16A (initially issued on September 28th 2016) identified the need to revise the Crandall Canyon Mine's final reclamation plan. A subsequent revision to DO-16A was issued on November 21st, 2016.

Since that time, discussions between Genwal Resources, Inc representatives and Division staff have occurred. As a result of those communications, an agreement has been reached that the issuance of a formal Division Order is not necessary at this time.

It is the Division understanding that Genwal Resources, Inc. will provide a revised reclamation plan for the re-establishment of approximate original contour in the north portal/highwall area of the Crandall Canyon Mine. Additionally, the Division understands that the revised reclamation plan design will take the mine-water discharge into account.

Upon receipt of this letter, you will have 90 days to submit the revised final reclamation plan to the Division. The revisions must be P.E. certified and developed per accepted and prudent engineering practices.
