The waste rock pile was inspected every quarter in 2019 with the last inspection occurring on October 3, 2020. (KRH)

The sediment pond at the CVWR site is a total containment pond. No discharge permit is assigned to this pond. From a complete oversight inspection with OSM the field notes show that the pond was inspected on October 3, 2019. Sediment levels were below the 60% clean elevation. The report was certified by a Utah P.E. (KRH)
