A complete inspection was conducted on September 12, 1984, at the above mentioned mine sites by Sandy Pruitt, Tom Wright, and Barton Kale of the Division. The purpose of this inspection was to determine if any recent mining activity has taken place.

The inspectors were required to walk the last one and a half miles or so due to the conditions of the access road. The mine site shows no sign of recent activity. The area consists of one switch back up to a coal pad with an exposed, oxidized coal seam. An old coal pile is on the pad and an old broken down wooden coal shoot comes off the pad to the road below.
