Purpose: To introduce ourselves and discuss the Coal Hollow surface coal mine application.

MEETING SUMMARY:

Using maps from the Mining and Reclamation Plan, the Division staff briefly described the location of the surface mine, the owners of the fee coal, the proposed mine layout, and mine life. We explained the review process and provided a written outline of time frames for the Public Comment Period and Technical Review. Open communication between the Division and the Alton town was encouraged. The Alton representatives asked how long the whole process would take. The Division estimated a minimum of one year – but it depends on the quality of the submittal.
