Our review team has completed the first round of comments for Alton Coal Companies proposed Coal Hollow mine. We discussed the review comments with Chris McCourt and his consulting group, Pat Collins (Biology) Erik Petersen(Geology and Hydrology) and Bob Long (Soils) on Monday the 8th of September. At the conclusion of the meeting we set a tentative date of October 1st for a site visit to gain a better understanding of how some of the resources, (soils, vegetation, wildlife species, air and water) may be affected by the proposed mining activities.

The two documents attached to this "E" mail include the Technical Analysis, TA dated August 26 and the list of deficiencies generated from the TA dated August 4th.
